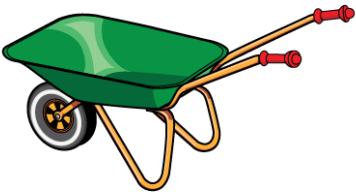


Henderson Creek Stream Clean-Up

Project Twin Streams Henderson Creek and the Te Atatu Endeavour Sea Scouts are co-ordinating a great event with kayaks, boats and stream-bank crews. It's a whole new perspective out on the stream!

Every year about **7 billion tonnes** of rubbish makes it way into the sea. **Eighty percent** of marine debris comes from land via our stormwater system, rivers and streams and is then transported out to sea. Help clean up the stream before the debris ends up in the sea—a great way to support Seaweek 2012!



There are many ways to join in:

- Bring your canoe or kayak and launch alongside the scouts
- Help with waste sorting & auditing
- Collect rubbish from the stream banks
- Help with afternoon tea
- Water testing activities with Wai Care
