- Work with the community not for profit sector and other stakeholders to recruit participants for the programme
- Oversee and monitor the budget for the Future Proofing programme
- Develop an evaluation framework that captures the outcomes/impact of the programme
- Collate reports for funders, the community or team members when required
- Support participants on the programme to identify funding opportunities to support their journey
